SAP Business One helps you run marketing campaigns with greater ease from start to finish, including analyzing the results. To plan your campaign, you can use the application to segment your contacts into target groups, for example, prospects by geography or industry and current customers by purchased product. An easy-to-use wizard then guides you through the steps to create and execute your marketing campaign. These include importing contact lists from Microsoft Excel and executing the campaign through e-mail and other methods. With integrated reports, you

can analyze your campaign performance, including response rates and overall success of the campaign.

With help from the software, you can readily convert a qualified lead from the campaign into a sales opportunity and follow up with a sales quotation. Again, integrated reports let you optimize your campaign follow-up process. For example, you can see the various opportunities created and sales quotes sent as a result of the campaign.



Create, execute, and analyze marketing campaigns with ease using SAP Business One.

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With SAP Business One, you can efficiently manage your activities through different stages in the sales cycle. Schedule and receive reminders for phone calls, meetings, and assigned tasks. Record any activity along with detailed notes and link it to customers, vendors, and leads from your desktop or mobile device. Link activities to a lead, and drill down into the details with one click. Synchronize your activities in SAP Business One with your personal schedule in Microsoft Outlook to manage your tasks with clarity.

The sales opportunity functionality lets you manage the entire sales process, as well as forecast revenue potential, and analyze sales outcomes. When you enter new opportunities with information about potential sales volumes, customers, specific competitors, expected closing dates, and sales stages, the application immediately calculates projected gross profit and revenue. As the opportunity progresses through sales stages and new data is entered, the expected profit and revenue calculations are updated dynamically.



Integrating Microsoft Outlook with the CRM functionality of SAP Business One makes it easy to manage your busy day.



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Once a sales opportunity has been won, you can create a sales order from it directly without having to reenter data. You can see the movement of goods into and out of your business and check the availability of ordered products in real time, because the software updates accounting data and inventory levels automatically. When necessary, the version of the application powered by SAP HANA provides the flexibility to reschedule orders dynamically. This enables you to deliver

goods to your customers as promised and maintain high customer satisfaction.

The application provides a variety of templates for business documents, such as quotations, order confirmations, and billings. This means you can create business documents and send them to your prospects and customers using standard PDF or other commonly used formats.



SAP Business One provides tight integration between CRM and inventory so you deliver what you promise when it's promised.



Gain insight from customer master data

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SAP Business One eases the management of master data for sales leads and customers.

A dedicated customer master record feature is used to create and maintain data in user-friendly screens or from a mobile device – such as name, address, phone and fax numbers, e-mail addresses, contacts, and tax information. In addition, you can manage important payment data such as terms, credit limits, and special discounts, as well as bank and credit card information. Data stored in a customer master record is automatically transferred to relevant transactions, such as sales quotations, orders, or deliveries. You are notified if credit

limits have been exceeded or if a customer is “on hold” due to delivery or payment issues.

A dashboard for the customer master record gives you an overview of account balances, outstanding orders, and deliveries, as well as opportunities in the pipeline. Also, because SAP Business One provides visibility into a customer’s complete purchase history and open purchase orders, you can expose trends and anticipate needs based on historical information. That means you can offer both the right products and services to customers and align your production activities and inventory with sales.



Manage services

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The service management functionality in SAP Business One simplifies the management of customer warranties, service contracts, and service calls. You can create service contracts based on warrantied products you are selling or create them separately for support services rendered for third-party products. The service contract contains information about items covered under the agreement, such as service, contact, and response time. With a variety of predefined templates, you can use an automated and standardized approach to crafting all types of contracts.

SAP Business One helps you document all customer service calls. A service call record

includes information about the customer, the service item, the issue reported, and activities performed in response to the call. Service reps can use mobile devices to view service contracts and manage the service call life-cycle – from viewing and picking up their service calls to closing a service call and tracking solution details.

The application also maintains a solutions knowledge base, where frequently requested information and solutions to common issues are recorded. This knowledge base helps service representatives respond more quickly and effectively to customer calls and reported problems.



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By taking advantage of the synchronization between Microsoft Outlook and SAP Business One, you can access customer and sales information through Microsoft Outlook even when you're offline. This also lets you synchronize calendars and activities and import customer data from SAP Business One into your Microsoft Outlook contacts list.

Another advantage is that you can sync e-mails and meetings from Microsoft Outlook to SAP Business One. For example, if SAP Business One sees an e-mail in Microsoft Outlook from George at ABC Company, it will record it in the SAP Business One application as an activity.

The quotation function enables you to display and edit existing quotations directly in Microsoft Outlook. You can create new quotations in Microsoft Outlook, store them in SAP Business One, and send them as e-mails to your prospect or customer. E-mails sent and received in Microsoft Outlook can be saved and retrieved as activities in SAP Business One. And, when using the SAP Business One mobile app, you can synchronize this information on your device.



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The reporting functionality of SAP Business One, including SAP® Crystal Reports® software, lets you create powerful sales reports and dashboards to stay on top of sales opportunities, conduct sales forecasts, and assess sales and service performance.

You can monitor sales across multiple dimensions, such as customer and sales stage, and create dashboards showing the information you need to see most in a single location. With report templates, you can create detailed sales reports, such as pipeline tracking.

A real-time overview of your service department lets you analyze call volumes, durations, and response times. The service call monitor creates alerts when preset limits for call

duration or volumes are exceeded, helping to guarantee timely response and resolution.

When powered by the SAP HANA platform, SAP Business One can take your business reporting to the next level, enabling employees to create and run ad hoc reports without requiring assistance from a consultant or IT expert. Visual and contextual reports can be embedded in familiar screens of the SAP Business One application. For example, when a customer's name is entered into a sales order screen, a side panel on the screen can open showing the products most often purchased by that customer. This enables your reps to make informed recommendations at the point of sale.



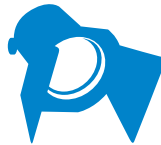
